GAME HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Tulsa picked up a win Thursday night by defeating the Reno Bighorns 85-79 at home. Tulsa's defense was strong by holding the Bighorns under 100 points for the first time in 10 games.
- Tulsa held Reno to just 10 points in the third quarter. The Bighorns shot just 25-67 (.373) from the floor overall.
- Jerome Dyson scored a 66ers season-high 31 points Thursday on 10-of-19 shooting. Aiding in the big night was a 10-for-10 effort from the free throw line.
- The 66ers shot a perfect 16-16 from the free throw line.
- The 66ers racked up 19 assists, led by Vaden and Dyson with four dishes each.
- Marcus Lewis picked up his 19th double-double of the season with 10 points and 13 rebounds.
- Oklahoma City Thunder assignee Ryan Reid added 10 points and a season-high 14 rebounds.
- The 66ers blocked eight shots as a team, led by Sumpter and Reid with two swats each.
